Regional Associations Coaches and Managers Form

This form should have been completed by the Regional Association for allocation of passes for coaches and team managers.

Passes

Passes will be issued to all swimmers, coaches, managers, SNZ staff, SCWS personnel and VIP's. Passes MUST be shown to access the facility via the south east doors DURING WARM-UP ONLY. Passes will be included in the regional packs as detailed below.

Pool Access/Entry

Access to the pool for those with a pass – swimmers, team managers, coaches, SNZ staff and SCWC personnel and VIP's is via the south east doors DURING WARM-UP ONLY.

These doors will be manned between the following times:

- 6.45am to 9am
- 3.45pm to 6pm

Outside these times access to QE II Leisure Centre is via the main entrance. Passes still need to be shown by those that have them.

Public and spectators will need to access the pool via the main entrance.

Exit

Everyone MUST exit the QE II facility via the main entrance through the toilets.

ALL DOORS in the QE II facility are alarmed at all times and are not EXITS. If people use these doors as exits QE II will not allow us future use of the south west door as an entrance to the facility.

Collection of Packs

Packs for team managers including session one programmes and passes can be collected by **CLUB TEAM MANAGERS** from the AOD room situated next to the 50 m competition pool between the following times

- 3pm-7pm

Officials meeting

An officials meeting will be held on Wednesday 12th April at 7.45am in the function room - which is situated down the stairs off the main entrance foyer of QE II.

Opening Ceremony

An Opening Ceremony will be held at 5.40pm on Wednesday 12th April.

Regions are to provide 3 representatives in uniform - 1 to carry the regional placard for the March past. These people are to assemble at the Dive Well end of the pool at 5.20pm in uniform.

Victory Ceremonies

SNZ has introduced a standard victory ceremony protocol for all SNZ National Competitions.

Victory Ceremonies will be timetabled in the Order of Events and the Victory Ceremony Timetable will be published in the souvenir programme and the programme for finals session.

Team managers and Coaches are to ensure swimmers are familiar with this protocol and timetable which is on the SNZ website.

A musical fanfare will be used to indicate the Victory Ceremony.

Swimmers who are not present **WILL NOT RECEIVE THEIR MEDAL**. Substitutes may be used if swimmers are in other races or in marshalling, however they must be of the **same gender** as the swimmer due to be receiving the medal.

Victory ceremonies will take place immediately after the following race – please see the Victory Ceremony Timetable for full details on the website.

IMMEDIATELY after finishing their race AND BEFORE warming down the TOP 4 swimmers should dry down, get their t shirt or tracksuit jacket and go to the presentation area. They must advise the presentation official they are present.

This meet will be swum under SNZ Regulations with the specific conditions & criteria:

- Age as at 12th April 2006.
- The NZ Youth and Open Championships will be used to determine the NZ Open Champions and the NZ Youth Champions for individual events for the following two age groups, 16 years, 17 & 18 years combined
- Relays will be regional and open.
- The qualifying period is from 1st March 2005 to 26th March 2006.
- Individual entry times may be verified against the SNZ Results Database. Performances from regional and local competitions not held within the Results Database may not be eligible for entry to national competitions.
- The qualifying times shown are 50 metre times. Qualifying times swum in pools other than 50ms must be converted to long course times using the SNZ conversions.
- All swimmers shall only enter qualified events.
- All entries must include swimmer details and times. The swimmers declared entry time shall be the fastest official time swum in the qualifying period. All relay entries must include swimmers' names whose times were used to produce the entry time. Only swimmers who have met the required individual qualifying standard may be entered in relay events.
- A maximum of two (2) international visitors may progress from heats to preliminary-finals or finals in any one event, with the exception of timed-finals where there is no limit on international visitor entries.

NOTE:

- 50, 100 and 200m events, there will be three preliminary finals (one for each Youth age group and one "Open Preliminary Final" for all other ages). Youth age group championship placings will be determined from the results of the Youth preliminary final. Open finalists will be determined from the results of the **three** preliminary finals.
- 400m events there will be Open A & B finals (the Open finalists will be determined from the fastest results of the heats, with the next fastest group of swimmers placed in the B final). The open championship placings will be determined from the A final. The Youth age group championship placings will be determined, as timed finals, from the results of the Open A & B finals and the heats, with placings in the A final taking precedence over the placings in the B final and placing in A & B finals taking precedence over the heats.
- For the 800m and 1500m events, the Youth age group placings will be determined from the results of the heats, as for timed finals; the Open finalists will also be determined from the results of the heats.
