

## Selection criteria

World Short Course Championships  
Shanghai, CHN 5-9 April 2006



### SWIMMER SELECTIONS:

#### 1. Eligible competitions

Swimmers will be selected from the 2005 NZ Summer Championships and International Trials (50m, Auckland 6-10 December 2005) and the Sydney World Cup (25m, 19-20 November 2005).

#### 2. Restrictions

2.1. The maximum number of swimmers per individual event is 2.

#### 3. Selections

Swimmers will be selected in the following priority order:

3.1. The winner in each event in the finals of the 2005 NZ Summer Championships and confirming their intention to compete at WSC will be selected.

3.2. The fastest swimmer equalling or bettering the SNZ WSC A (25m) qualifying standard at the Sydney World Cup will be selected.

3.3. In events with places still available after 3.1 and 3.2 the next fastest swimmer equalling or bettering the SNZ WSC B (50m) qualifying standard at the 2005 NZ Summer Championships and confirming their intention to compete at WSC will be selected.

3.4. The fastest four swimmers for each relay event (including those selected under 3.1 and 3.2), will be selected if the combined times are equal or faster than SNZ R (Athens 12<sup>th</sup> place). An allowance of 0.65 seconds will be allowed for relay takeovers when ranking swimmers. Swimmers selected only through criteria 3.4 will be entered in individual events at the World SC Championships at the discretion of the Director of Coaching.

#### 4. Confirmation of participation

All selected swimmers must confirm their participation by the conclusion of the finals session at the 2005 NZ Summer Championships, 10 December 2005 and sign the SNZ Athlete Agreement before selection can be ratified.

#### 5. Retirement

In accordance with FINA rules DC 11.1, 11.2 and 11.3, a competitor who has previously given notice of retirement to SNZ will not be eligible for selection unless he or she notifies SNZ at least 9 months prior to the competition and is available for unannounced drug testing at any time during the period before their return to actual competition.

#### 6. Championship preparation

All selected swimmers must attend and fully participate in all programmed training camps, competitions and other team activities between selection and the World Short Course Championships unless given specific exemption by the Director of Coaching.

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### SNZ WSC Qualifying standards

- WSC A is World 25m 5<sup>th</sup> (2001-04 combined rankings) plus 2%
- WSC B is World 50m 5<sup>th</sup> (2001-04 combined rankings) plus 4%
- SNZ R is 12th place at Athens 2004
