Warm-up Procedure

SNZ will use the standard warm up Procedure for all National Competitions to comply with OSH requirements.

Details of the Warm-up procedure at each venue are on the SNZ website.

Marshalling

Marshalling for each venue is detailed below. The number of events or races prior to the start will be advised at the Team Managers Meeting.

Northern - Auckland

Marshalling will take place at the scoreboard end of the pool behind the scoreboard.

Central - Wellington

Marshalling will be at the deep end of the pool just along from the door entry on the bleaches.

Southern - Southland

Marshalling will take place in the south west corner of the 50m pool.

CONDITIONS

The 2009 NZ Junior Championships will be conducted in accordance with the Swimming New Zealand Regulations as published on 2 October 2008 and FINA Rules. All events will start promptly. Competitors must be ready when called, or the event will start without them.

PROTESTS - Protests must be lodged in accordance with SNZ Regulations. Protests will be as detailed in SNZ Regulation 4. The fee for a protest is \$50.00.

WITHDRAWALS - Withdrawals will be as detailed in SNZ Regulation 3. The fine for failure to withdraw from a final is \$50.00. Note: All NZ Juniors events are timed finals and SNZ Regulation 3 applies.

3.2 For timed finals, withdrawals must be advised by the end of the session preceding the start of the timed final event. i.e.; the day before.

Please send details of any scratching for Session One - Saturday 21st February to the following people by 8pm Friday 20th February. If swimmers scratch in the morning of Saturday 21st Feb or do not turn up to swim, SNZ Regulation 3.2 and the \$50 fine will apply.

Scratchings for Session Two and Three must be handed to the recorder by the completion of the session prior or emailed to the following addresses also.

National Results

Results for NZ Junior Championships are collated at each venue and then National Results merged from the 3 venues results via email at the SNZ Wellington office.

Due to differing numbers of entries at each venue event results are not always available at the same time from each venue.

Therefore, there may be delays in producing National results and therefore holding victory ceremonies.

SNZ will endeavor to produce the National results as soon as practicable after each event.

Quick Results

SNZ will have LIVE/Quick Results on the SNZ website. The results for each event nationally will be posted on the website.

Timelines

Timelines will be included on the session sheets. The times shown are approximate and races may start before or after the times indicated. It is the swimmers' responsibility to be at marshalling at the appropriate time.

Session Programmes and Results

Session Programmes will be issued to regional team managers based on the number of Coaches and Managers detailed in the Regional Coaches and Managers Form.

Session programmes and 1 results sheet per Region will be distributed to REGIONAL ASSOCIATIONS in the following places for each venue.

Results will also be posted in places at each venue as detailed below.

Northern - Auckland

Session Programmes and 1 result per Region will be placed in the Regional Association boxes outside the Control Room.

Results will be placed on the Ground floor - on the white results board at the dive well end and down the scoreboard end by marshalling; and upstairs - on the white results board at the dive well end of the pool (just along from the top of the stairs) and upstairs behind the scoreboard on the windows.

Central - Wellington

Session programmes and 1 result per region will be placed in the Regional Association boxes next to the ladies changing rooms.

Results will be placed on the far wall by the dive well, near the roller door on the grandstand side, on the windows at the start end of the pool and by the rear entrance.

Southern - Invercargill

Session programmes and 1 result per region will be placed in the Regional Association boxes in the Russell Cushen Room.

Results will be placed on the glass windows outside Leisure Pool, glass windows by Wave Pool, whiteboard at Eastern end of 50m pool and whiteboard at marshalling.

Parking

Northern - Auckland

Parking at the main car park at West Wave Aquatic Centre is restricted and frequently monitored by parking wardens. Parking is available in the car park of the Falls Restaurant. Opening Ceremony

A small Opening Ceremony will be held at each venue before the start of the 1st session. Times for each venue and regional requirements are detailed below.

Victory Ceremonies

Victory ceremonies for National 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be held at each venue as advised by the venue.

Victory ceremonies cannot be timetabled into the order of events due not knowing when the National results will be available.

A musical fanfare will be used to indicate the Victory Ceremony.

Dress Standard for Victory Ceremonies

The following dress standard is required for victory ceremonies.

- Club or regional t-shirt, jacket or sweatshirt
- No caps or goggles
- No towels to be wrapped around the waist
- Tracksuit bottoms or shorts are NOT required.

Swimmers who are not present will not receive their medal/ribbon. Substitutes may be used if swimmers are in other races or in marshalling, however they must be of the same gender as the swimmer due to be receiving the medal/ribbon.
