Nomination Event	2010 NZ Open Long Course Championships, Auckland, 5-10 April, 2010
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for nomination, a swimmer must meet all of the following eligibility criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A New Zealand citizen who is eligible to represent New Zealand in the Competition as per FINA General Rule 2 (GR2) 2. A registered member of Swimming New Zealand in good standing 3. Have signed an Swimming New Zealand Athlete Agreement 4. Be available to fulfill the Team Commitments as outlined by SNZ Head Coach - (“Head Coach”) at the nomination event. 5. Meet all the requirements of the NZOC as outlined in the <u>NZOC-Swimming NZ agreement</u>
Team Commitments	<p>All swimmers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of their SNZ Athletes Agreement at all times 2. Conform to SNZ requirements regarding team preparation 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by the General Manager Performance & Pathways (GMPP) and the Head Coach 4. Athletes nominate to NZOC for selection must sign the <u>NZOC athlete agreement</u> & <u>NSO agreement</u> (Section A) before selection announcements are made.

Performance Requirement	<p>Criteria for nomination to NZOC for individual events:</p> <p>To be nominated to NZOC for individual events at the 2010 Commonwealth Games swimmers will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Record a qualifying time at the NZ LC Championships April 2010 by swimming a time in the final of an Olympic event, which is equal to, or faster than, the times outlined below. 2. Relay splits and other split times will not be considered for nomination for an individual event, nor for nomination to relays. 3. A maximum of 3 swimmers per event may be nominated. 4. SNZ may consider nominating a swimmer to NZOC who is outside the selection criteria, for whom a case could be made regarding their outstanding long term potential (London 2012). 5. At the discretion of the SNZ selectors, GMPP and the Head Coach, swimmers who are nominated for one Olympic event may request to swim one other event in that stroke where there is an available position. Priority will be for those swimmers who finish first in that event at the selection event. 2. Where a qualified swimmer in an Olympic event, wishes to also swim a Non Olympic event, in that stroke, this request will be granted if the swimmer achieves 900 FINA points (based on the document titled "FINA Point Scoring 2008 – Long Course 50m") in that non Olympic event. 	<p>Criteria for nomination to NZOC for relay events:</p> <p>A relay team will be nominated to NZOC for selection as follows:</p> <p>Freestyle relay nomination for the Commonwealth Games will be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The first four finishers in the finals of the 100m and 200m freestyle individual events at the Nomination Event will be nominated if the aggregate time of that relay is equal to or faster than the nomination time detailed below. <p>Medley relay nomination for the Commonwealth Games will be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The winner of the 100m butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke and freestyle individual events in the final of those events will be nominated for selection if the aggregate time is equal to or faster than the nomination time detailed below. For the butterfly, backstroke, or breaststroke selections, the highest placed swimmer in that 100m event at the Commonwealth Games (by the time the medley relay nominations are submitted) will be selected for the team, or if no swimmer has been selected for a 100m event, then, the fastest 100m swimmer respectively from the Nomination Event will be selected to swim that leg of the medley relay at the Commonwealth Games if the team qualifies. <p>Team Size</p>	<p>Team size for individual events will be in accordance with the FINA rules. If the number of athletes meeting the performance criteria exceeds the FINA limit, the highest ranked swimmers who satisfy the nomination criteria will be selected.</p>												
<p>Notes</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> SNZ nominates swimmers to NZOC, who then select for the 2010 Commonwealth Games team. The nomination criteria, once approved, can be amended only with the mutual consent of SNZ and the NZOC. Selection of the 2010 Commonwealth Games team will be announced by the NZOC in conjunction with SNZ, following the nomination event, 2010 NZ LC Champs April 10th 2010. A swimmer may be nominated by SNZ to the NZOC if in the 12 months prior to the Nomination Meet they: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> have met the Performance Requirement, but are unable to compete at the Nomination Event, due to extenuating circumstances which meet SNZ approval, have a top 16 world ranking in an Olympic event in the year prior to selection the following may be considered: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the case of injury or illness, the swimmer is able to provide, in advance of the selection event, a medical certificate from the SNZ Medical Director. 	<p>certificate must indicate the current and future performance impact of the condition.</p> <p>-Selectors, in conjunction with the GM P&P may consider these circumstances for selection.</p> <p>NB: Selection of a swimmer, as outlined in Note 4, will be subject to confirmation of their satisfactory return to training. This process to include a test (under legitimate competitive conditions - referee, starter, turn judges, electronic timing) in the event selected. This test to be performed by a designated date confirmed by GM P&P and SNZ Head Coach. A target time indicating satisfactory progress will be decided by the SNZ selectors, GM P&P and SNZ Head Coach and communicated to the swimmer by a designated date.</p>
