Set up of Competition

There will be heats and finals for 50s, 100s, 200s and 400s. The 800 and 1500 free will be timed finals.

Relay events 22/23 and 49/50 will be straight finals due to having 10 or less entries.

Pre-Meet Training Times

The pool will be available and set at 25m on Friday 5 August between 3pm – 7pm.

Pool entry is free for training at these times. Entry to the complex is through main entrance.

PLEASE NOTE: Clubs that wish to train outside this time will have to pay pool entry. SNZ recommends that clubs make arrangements with facilities to ensure there is available space.

Information

Pool Access/Entry

Access to the pool for everyone attending the Championship is through the main entrance of the pool. Swimmers and support staff with events passes must wear them or they will be charged an entrance fee.

Collection of Packs

Packs for team managers including heats Programmes and passes must be collected by **CLUB TEAM MANAGERS** from meeting room 1 under the main stand on Friday 5th August between 3-7pm.

Officials meeting

An officials meeting will be held on Saturday 6th August at 8am in the Meeting Room 1 at WRAC.

Officials food

Officials Breakfast will be available each day between 7.30am – 8.30am in Meeting Room 1 at Wellington Regional Aquatic Centre.

Afternoon tea will be available each day between 3.30pm – 4.30pm in Meeting Room 1 at WRAC.

Depending on the session lengths, food may be served to officials during the session. Drinks will be provided.

Officials Happy Hour

A Happy Hour will be held for officials on Monday 8th August after the finals session in Meeting Room 1 at WRAC. This will consist of drinks and light food.

Seating

Seating will be allocated for regional teams and will be rotated daily. The seating plans will be placed on the SNZ website.

Session Programmes and Results

Relay Names and Withdrawal forms will be available from the recorders desk. Finals Session programmes as outlined on the regional coaches and managers' form will be placed in the Regional Team Manager's boxes.

Results

After each event, results will be posted on each side of the dive well, with a full set of results placed in the regional manager's box at the end of

each session. Results are also available on the SNZ website.

Quick Results

SNZ will have Live/Quick Results on the SNZ website. The results for each event will be uploaded once the event has been signed off.

Timelines

Timelines will be included on the session sheets. The times shown are approximate and races may start before or after the times indicated. It is the swimmers' responsibility to be at marshalling at the appropriate time.

Spectator Charges

All spectators must enter the Wellington Regional Aquatic Centre via the front entrance to the pool. The following entry costs are to be paid.

programme and the programme for finals sessions.

Team managers and Coaches are to ensure swimmers are familiar with this protocol and timetable, which is on the SNZ website.

A musical fanfare will be used to indicate the Victory Ceremony.

Swimmers who are not present will not receive their medal. Substitutes may be used if swimmers are in other races or in marshalling, however they must be of the same gender as the swimmer due to be receiving the medal.

Victory ceremonies will take place immediately after the following race – please see the Victory Ceremony Timetable on the website.

Immediately after finishing their race and before warming down the top 3 swimmers should dry down, get their tee shirt or tracksuit jacket and go to the presentation area. They must advise the presentation official they are present.

We will endeavour to run the victory ceremonies as timetabled. If for any reason there is a delay in the results being available, the victory ceremony for that event will take place as soon as possible. The victory ceremonies will continue to happen as timetabled.

Dress standard for victory ceremonies

- Club or regional t-shirt, jacket or sweatshirt.
- No caps or goggles.
- No towels to be wrapped around the waist.
- Tracksuit bottoms or shorts are NOT required.

Disqualifications

Disqualifications will be announced and a copy of the DQ form put in the Regional Team Manager box.

Banner placement

SNZ will have signage at the State Insurance 2011 New Zealand Short Course Championships. This

signage will take precedence for position over regional and club banners.

Certificates

Certificates for State Insurance New Zealand Short Course Championships will be sent to clubs/regions after the meet from SNZ.

Merchandise
