Selection Events	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. New Zealand Age Group Championships, Wellington, 6th to 10th March 2012. 2. New Zealand Long Course Championships, Auckland, 25th to 30th March 2012.
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must meet all of the following eligibility criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A New Zealand citizen who is eligible to represent New Zealand in competition as per FINA General Rule 2 (GR2). 2. A registered member of Swimming New Zealand in good financial standing. 3. Have signed a Swimming New Zealand Athlete Agreement. 4. Be 13 to 18 years of age on the first day of competition of the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii. 5. Be available to fulfill the Team Commitments as outlined below if selected, and any additional commitments following selection. 6. Have not previously represented New Zealand in any of the following events – World Championships (Long Course), Pan Pacific Championships, Commonwealth Games and Olympic Games and finished in the top 16 in an individual event at one of these competitions. 7. Any swimmer selected for the Junior Pan Pacific Championships (JPP) who is subsequently selected for the 2012 London Olympic Games will become ineligible to compete at the Junior Pan Pacific Championships.
Team Commitments	<p>All swimmers selected will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Compete at a Selection Event unless granted an exemption under the provisions of these criteria by SNZ Selectors. 2. Comply with the provisions of their Swimming New Zealand Athletes Agreement at all times. 3. Conform to Swimming New Zealand requirements regarding team participation. This includes but may not be limited to providing an acceptable IPP, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 4. Train and keep themselves in the best possible mental and physical condition to enable them to compete at the Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii, to the highest possible standard, and make themselves available for all team activities designated by SNZ.

Performance Requirement

Criteria for selection for pool events for Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii 2012.

A maximum of 2 male and 2 female New Zealand eligible swimmers per event may be considered for selection.

To be selected for individual events at the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii, swimmers will:

1. Record a time equal to or better than the times (as detailed below) of an Olympic event, at a Selection Event.

Other Conditions:

1. In the sole discretion of the SNZ Selectors, eligible swimmers who are selected for the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii, may on request be able to swim in other events where there is an available position. Priority will be for those swimmers who are the highest ranked in that event at the Selection Events.

Criteria for Selection for Relay Events:

1. Selections for relays for the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships will be made from within the team selected for the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii.
2. The final composition of the relay teams will be determined by the coaching staff at the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii in their sole discretion.

Further Information:

1. Relay and other splits will not be considered for selection for an individual event nor for selection to relays.
2. If 4 swimmers (being 2 male and 2 female) do not achieve the qualifying standard at the Selection Events, SNZ Selectors at their sole discretion have the mandate to select such further eligible swimmers ("wild cards") so as to make the maximum of 2 male and 2 female swimmers to represent SNZ at the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Hawaii.
3. Selection of the "wild cards" will be based on the Highest FINA Points scorers at the Selection Events.

Selection Criteria –2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships (Pool Events)



Team Size/Announcement	<p>Team size for individual events will be in accordance with FINA rules. If the number of athletes meeting the performance criteria exceeds the FINA limit, the highest ranked swimmers who satisfy the selection criteria will be selected.</p> <p>All team announcements will be released to the media by SNZ.</p>
Notes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Swimming New Zealand may amend these selection criteria in its sole discretion by giving notice to eligible swimmers prior to the commencement of the New Zealand Age Group Championships, Wellington. 2. In the event that a swimmer has in the 12 months prior to the Selection Events met the Performance Requirement and is unable to compete at the Selection Events due to extenuating circumstances, the previous performance may be considered by the SNZ Selectors. In the event of illness or injury a medical certificate will be requested, indicating the current and future performance impact of the condition. Selection of a swimmer, as outlined above, will be subject to confirmation of their satisfactory return to training. This process to include a test (under legitimate competitive conditions i.e. starter, turn judges and electronic timing) in the event selected. This test must be performed by a designated date decided by SNZ Selectors. A target time indicating satisfactory progress will be decided by the SNZ Selectors and announced to the swimmer by the designated date. 3. If a swimmer is unable to satisfy SNZ requirements after selection and needs to withdraw from the team, then the SNZ Selectors may at their discretion select the next swimmer who has met all the eligibility and performance requirements. The SNZ Selectors reserve the right to request that any swimmer being considered for selection under the provisions of this clause undertakes a fitness test, the parameters of which will be determined by the SNZ Selectors at their sole discretion. 4. Attendance at the 2012 Junior Pan Pacific Championships is on a user pays basis.
