

## SNZ 2011 National Event Camp Distance Free & Medley

### 2011 National Event Camp

### Eligibility

To be eligible for selection to the SNZ national event camp (LC Camp), the swimmer must be a New Zealand citizen who is eligible to represent New Zealand according to the rules of FINA and is currently a registered member of Swimming New Zealand in good standing.

### Objectives

1. to bring together the best of our distance and medley swimmers in a positive productive environment
2. to promote and provide knowledge in these events
3. to develop both coaches and swimmers in technical and strategic areas for these events
4. to develop networks for coaches and swimmers who are identified as our best in these events

### Selection Criteria

<b>Date:</b>	January 24-28 <sup>th</sup> , 2011
<b>Location:</b>	Auckland (MISH)
<b>Target Group:</b>	Distance Free & 400 IM swimmers
<b>Team Size:</b>	24 swimmers
<b>Selection Period:</b>	SC performances from 1 July to December 2010
<b>Selection Criteria:</b>	Swimmers will be ranked by FINA Points up to a maximum of 12 females and 12 male swimmers (minimum standard 750 FINA pts) combination of Freestyle and IM stroke categories taken off KIWI Rankings (Take Your Marks).
<b>Stroke Categories:</b>	Free: 400m-800m Women/400-1500m Men IM: 400m
<b>Staff Size:</b>	SNZ Senior Performance Coach Team Manager 4 Selected Coaches
<b>Staff Selection:</b>	Top 2 Freestyle Coaches (FINA Points) Top 2 IM Coaches (FINA Points)  <i>Coaches must be a minimum of Bronze certified to be eligible for selection</i>
<b>Cost Share:</b>	The National distance & medley Camp is funded by SNZ
