



# SNZ 2012 National Camp Breaststroke

## 2012 National Event Camp Selection Summary

## Eligibility

To be eligible for selection to the SNZ National Event Camp – Breaststroke, the swimmer must be a New Zealand citizen who is eligible to represent New Zealand according to the rules of FINA and is currently a registered member of Swimming New Zealand in good standing. The swimmer must be training in New Zealand with an affiliated Swimming New Zealand club.

## Selection Criteria

- Date:** 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2012
- Location:** Auckland (MISH)
- Target Group:** Top New Zealand Breaststrokers
- Team Size:** 22 swimmers
- Selection Period:** Performances from NZ Short Course Champs; 6-9<sup>th</sup> August 2011
- Selection Criteria:** Swimmers will be ranked by FINA Points up to a maximum of 11 females and 11 male swimmers in Breaststroke category taken off KIWI Rankings (Take Your Marks).
- Stroke Category:** 100m & 200m Breaststroke
- Staff Size:** SNZ Youth & Age and Open Water Manager  
SNZ Performance Coach – Mark Regan  
5 Male & 5 Female Coaches
- Staff Selection:** Top 5 Male Breaststroke Coaches (FINA Points)  
Top 5 Female Breaststroke Coaches (FINA Points)
- Coaches must be a minimum of Bronze certified to be eligible for selection*
- Cost Share:** The National Breaststroke Camp is fully funded by SNZ.
