

SNZ 2012 National Programme Outward Bound Camp

2012 Outward Bound Personal Development Selection Summary

The intent of this document is to give athletes and coaches an overview of the National programme selection protocols. Any questions can be directed to Philip Rush (Youth & Age and Open Water Manager) at philip@swimmingnz.org.nz.

Eligibility

To be eligible for selection to the SNZ Outward Bound Personal Development Camp, the swimmer must be a New Zealand citizen who is eligible to represent New Zealand according to the rules of FINA and is currently a registered member of Swimming New Zealand in good standing. The swimmer must be training in New Zealand with an affiliated Swimming New Zealand club.

Selection Criteria

- Date:** 15th - 22nd April, 2012
- Location:** Anakiwa, Picton
- Target Group:** Swimmers between 16-20 years of age
- Team Size:** 14 swimmers
- Selection Period:** LC performances from NZ Age Group Championships 6-10th March, 2012 and from National Open Championships 25-30th March, 2012
- Selection Criteria:**
- The top 7 male and 7 female swimmers from selection events
 - 20 years old and under
 - Highest FINA point rankings
- NB: Swimmers who have already attended Outward Bound in previous years are not eligible for the April 2012 course.
- Aims:** The Outward Bound Camp will encourage our swimmers to become more balanced, positive and motivated young adults.
- Staff Size:** SNZ Youth & Age and Open Water Manager
- Cost Share:** SNZ, in partnership with Outward Bound will fully subsidise the cost of the Outward Bound camp. *However, it will be the responsibility of the selected swimmer to arrange & cover costs of their own travel to Wellington.* SNZ will cover all costs from that point.
