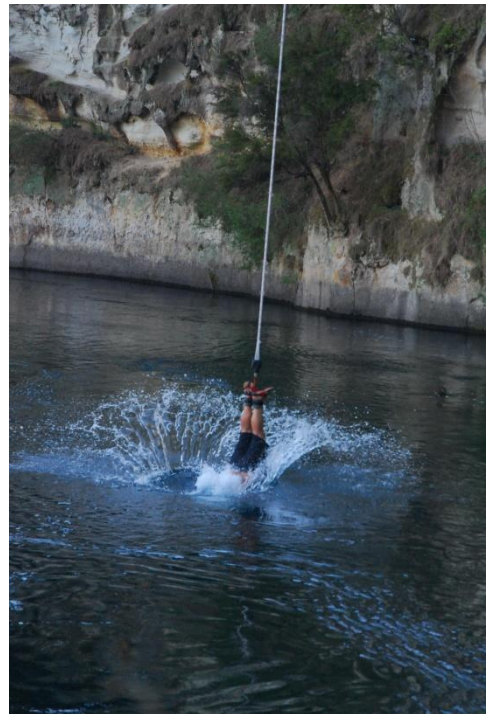




Smoke signals
